5 Relating to End Domestic Violence
6 and Sexual Assault Month.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS Alaska, as a national leader in the effort to secure dignity
9 and equality for women, has engaged in legal reform, established a commis-
10 sion on the status of women, and provided funding for shelters for battered
11 women and their children, batterer's counseling projects, rape crisis cen-
12 ters, and women's resource centers; and

13 WHEREAS continued support for this effort is necessary to assure the
14 freedom and safety of women in Alaska; and

15 WHEREAS the governor has proclaimed May 1981 as End Domestic Violence
16 and Sexual Assault Month in Alaska and has called upon all citizens to help
17 build a society in which women can be freed from terror and violent assault;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature joins the governor in
19 proclaiming May 1981 as End Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Month and
20 encourages the people of Alaska and communities and educational institutions
21 in the state to observe this month with appropriate activities to help
22 assure that women will be freed from domestic violence and sexual assault.
