BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities operates

10

and maintains the transportation facilities of the state including state

11

highways; and

12

WHEREAS the management of state highways includes the determination and

13

posting of appropriate speed limits for traffic on those highways; and

14

WHEREAS the present speed limit at Ninilchik between Mile 134.6 and Mile

15

137 of the Sterling Highway is 45 miles per hour; and

16

WHEREAS the safety and general welfare of the people of Ninilchik and

17

those traveling the Sterling Highway would be enhanced if the speed of

18

traffic were reduced between Mile 134.6 and Mile 137 of the Sterling Highway;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is

20

respectfully requested to direct the commissioner of transportation and

21

public facilities to take the necessary action to reduce the speed limit

22

between Mile 134.6 and Mile 137 of the Sterling Highway from 45 miles per

23

hour to 35 miles per hour.
