2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 49 am S  
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
4 TWELFTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the speed limits at  
6 Ninilchik from Mile 134.6 to Mile  
7 137 of the Sterling Highway and  
8 from the Parks Highway to Mile 1.0  
9 of the Petersville Road.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 WHEREAS the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities operates  
12 and maintains the transportation facilities of the state including state  
13 highways; and

14 WHEREAS the management of state highways includes the determination and  
15 posting of appropriate speed limits for traffic on those highways; and

16 WHEREAS the present speed limit at Ninilchik between Mile 134.6 and Mile  
17 137 of the Sterling Highway is 45 miles per hour; and

18 WHEREAS the safety and general welfare of the people of Ninilchik and  
19 those traveling the Sterling Highway would be enhanced if the speed of  
20 traffic were reduced between Mile 134.6 and Mile 137 of the Sterling Highway;  
21 and

22 WHEREAS the present speed limit from the Parks Highway to Mile 1.0 of  
23 the Petersville Road is 40 miles per hour; and

24 WHEREAS the safety and general welfare of the people of Petersville  
25 Road would be enhanced if the speed of traffic were reduced from the Parks  
26 Highway to Mile 1.0 of the Petersville Road;

27 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is  
28 respectfully requested to direct the commissioner of transportation and  
29 public facilities to take the necessary action to reduce the speed limit

1 between Mile 134.6 and Mile 137 of the Sterling Highway from 45 miles per  
2 hour to 35 miles per hour and to reduce the speed limit from the Parks High-  
3 way to Mile 1.0 of the Petersville Road from 40 miles per hour to 30 miles  
4 per hour.
