8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the fourteenth annual Girls' State will be held June 20 - 26,  
10 1982, at the Sitka Public Safety Academy under the sponsorship of the  
11 American Legion and cooperating organizations; and

12 WHEREAS this fine annual program of the Legion ranks high among the  
13 efforts of several Alaskan organizations to bring to the youth delegates an  
14 awareness of their future roles in state and local government; and

15 WHEREAS this week-long youth citizen exercise of Girls' State at the  
16 Sitka Public Safety Academy is made possible by an admirable combination of  
17 volunteer service and the free enterprise of generous people and organiza-  
18 tions without dependence on government or any burden on the taxpayer; and

19 WHEREAS it is consistent with these standards for the legislature to  
20 encourage state and local legislators and other public officials and agencies  
21 to volunteer their services and provide copies of state publications and  
22 materials related to the program;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature salutes the sponsors of  
24 and participants in the fourteenth annual Girls' State program; commends to  
25 the attention of government officials and agencies and private individuals  
26 and organizations the opportunity to support and participate in this exercise  
27 in youth citizenship; and pledges to continue to provide legislative mater-  
28 als, advice and encouragement to the Girls' State program as it does to  
29 similar worthy civic efforts.
