3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 TWELFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the ratification of an  
6 amendment to the Constitution of the  
7 United States defining Congressional  
8 representation and voting rights for  
9 residents of the District of Columbia.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 WHEREAS the Congress of the United States has approved a proposed  
12 amendment to the Constitution of the United States that provides for the  
13 election by residents of the District of Columbia of United States Senators  
14 and United States Representatives on the same basis as their election by  
15 residents of the several states, and repeals the 23rd Amendment to the  
16 Constitution of the United States but retains the right of the residents of  
17 the District of Columbia to vote for the election of the President and Vice  
18 President of the United States; and

19 WHEREAS the proposed amendment to the Constitution of the United States  
20 has been transmitted to the states for ratification;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Twelfth Alaska Legislature ratifies the pro-  
22 posed amendment to the Constitution of the United States establishing repre-  
23 sentation in Congress for residents of the District of Columbia on the same  
24 basis as the several states and confirming the right of the residents of the  
25 District of Columbia to vote for the election of President and Vice President  
26 of the United States.
