5 Requesting the Congress of the
6 United States to propose a human
7 life amendment to the United States
8 Constitution.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS under Article V of the United States Constitution the Congress
11 of the United States may propose an amendment to the constitution and may
12 then submit the proposed amendment to the legislatures of the several states
13 for ratification; and

14 WHEREAS there is a great need at this time for the United States
15 Congress to consider the issue of abortion and to act on a proposal for a
16 human life amendment to the Constitution of the United States; and

17 WHEREAS passage of this joint resolution will encourage the Congress of
18 the United States to propose a human life amendment to the United States
19 Constitution;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Twelfth Alaska State Legislature requests the
21 United States Congress to propose a human life amendment under Article V of
22 the United States Constitution.

23 COPIES of this resolution, properly certified, shall be sent to the
24 President of the United States Senate, the Secretary of the United States
25 Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the Clerk
26 of the United States House of Representatives, to each member of the Alaska
27 delegation to Congress, and to the presiding officers of the legislatures in
28 each of the other states, attesting to the adoption of this resolution.
