5 Requesting the President of the
6 United States to grant a pardon to
7 Daniel Boone Reed.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS Daniel Boone Reed, having been convicted of arson in 1941 and
10 having served eight years in federal jail, had his civil rights revoked; and

11 WHEREAS Daniel Boone Reed has been an exemplary, law-abiding citizen
12 since his release from jail more than 30 years ago; and

13 WHEREAS Daniel Boone Reed, now in his seventies and a longtime resident
14 of Kodiak Island, is a leader among its senior citizens and well respected
15 throughout the community;

16 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests
17 that the President of the United States grant Daniel Boone Reed a full
18 pardon and restore his civil rights.

19 COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Ronald Reagan,
20 President of the United States; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens and the
21 Honorable Frank Murkowski, U.S. Senators, and the Honorable Don Young, U.S.
22 Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
