4 TWELFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Proposing amendments to the Consti-  
6 tution of the State of Alaska relat-  
7 ing to the location of the state  
8 capital.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. Article XII, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended  
11 by adding a new section to read:

12 SECTION 14. STATE CAPITAL. After October 1, 1984, the capital of  
13 the State of Alaska shall be either at Juneau or at a site chosen by  
14 the Twelfth Alaska Legislature, as determined by the majority of the  
15 qualified voters voting on a proposition appearing on the election  
16 ballot at the 1982 general election.

17 \* Sec. 2. Article XV, sec. 20, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is  
18 repealed.

19 \* Sec. 3. The amendment and the repeal proposed by this resolution shall  
20 be placed before the voters of the state at the next general election in  
21 conformity with article XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska,  
22 and the election laws of the state.
