2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 52

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 TWELFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Proposing that Congress take certain
6 actions to permit timely construction
7 of the Bradley Lake hydroelectric
8 project.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS the United States Army Corps of Engineers is completing a
11 general design memorandum on the Bradley Lake hydroelectric project; and

12 WHEREAS the Army Corps of Engineers is requesting authorization and
13 funding from Congress to initiate construction of the project; and

14 WHEREAS there is a possibility that Congress will not appropriate money
15 for the project in a manner to permit expeditious construction of the pro-
16 ject; and

17 WHEREAS the Bradley Lake hydroelectric project is an economically,
18 environmentally, and technically feasible renewable energy project which
19 should be constructed as early as possible; and

20 WHEREAS the Alaska State Legislature desires to invest money available
21 from nonrenewable resources in self-renewing hydroelectric facilities for
22 the long-term benefit of its citizens; and

23 WHEREAS the State of Alaska, through the Alaska Power Authority, desires
24 to develop the project as early as possible;

25 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests
26 the Congress of the United States to authorize the U.S. Treasury to accept
27 state money for construction of the project.

29 President Pro Tempore of the United States Senate; the Honorable Thomas P.

1 O'Neill, Jr., Speaker of the United States House of Representatives; and to
2 the Honorable Ted Stevens and the Honorable Frank Murkowski, U.S.
3 Senators, and the Honorable Don Young, U.S. Representative, members of the
4 Alaska delegation in Congress.
