4 TWELFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to domestic short-wave
6 radio broadcasting.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS Alaska's population is small and distributed throughout a huge
9 geographic area; and

10 WHEREAS the expense of providing FM and standard (AM) radio broadcast
11 service to these areas is prohibitive; and

12 WHEREAS short-wave broadcasting is an economical means of providing
13 radio service to remote villages and communities of Alaska;

14 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska House of Representatives favors an
15 amendment of the Federal Communications Commission rules to allow domestic
16 short-wave broadcasting in Alaska.

17 COPIES OF THIS RESOLUTION shall be sent to the Honorable Robert E. Lee,
18 Acting Chairman, Federal Communications Commission; and to the Honorable Ted
19 Stevens and the Honorable Frank Murkowski, U. S. Senators, and the Honorable
20 Don Young, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in
21 Congress.
