6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to a pension plan for Alaska pilots  
7 and liens for payment of marine pilotage fees; and  
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 08.62.040 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

11 (c) The board may, by regulation, establish a pension plan to  
12 provide pension benefits to retired or disabled pilots and to the  
13 surviving spouses of deceased pilots. If a pension plan is established,  
14 the board shall finance it from pilotage fees imposed under this  
15 chapter.

16 \* Sec. 2. AS 08.62.170 is amended to read:

17 Sec. 08.62.170. LIENS [PILOT'S LIEN] FOR COMPENSATION OF PILOTS  
18 AND PAYMENT OF PILOTAGE FEES. Each vessel, its tackle, apparel and  
19 furniture and the owner of the vessel are jointly and severally liable  
20 for the compensation of a pilot employed on the vessel and for the  
21 payment of pilotage fees imposed by the board under this chapter. The  
22 [AND THE] pilot has a lien on the vessel, her tackle, apparel and  
23 furniture for his compensation. The board has a lien on the vessel,  
24 her tackle, apparel and furniture for the payment of pilotage fees.

25 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10-  
26 070(c).
