6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to local service roads and trails;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 19.30.171(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) The costs incurred by the commissioner in acquiring this
11 land or interest in land includes all costs and any fees incidental to
12 acquisition. All costs incurred in connection with the acquisition of
13 the land or interest in land for local governments [THAT HAVE ASSUMED
14 LOCAL ROAD POWERS] shall be paid by the local government for which the
15 land or interest in land is acquired. [RIGHT-OF-WAY ACQUISITION COSTS
16 INCURRED BY THE COMMISSIONER FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENTS WITHOUT LOCAL ROAD
17 POWERS UNDER AS 19.30.151(a) SHALL BE CHARGED TO THE PROJECT ALLOCA-
18 TION FOR THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT FOR WHICH THE LAND OR INTEREST IN LAND
19 IS ACQUIRED.]

20 * Sec. 2. AS 19.30.181 is repealed and reenacted to read:

21 Sec. 19.30.181. PROJECT AGREEMENTS. (a) A local government which
22 has assumed local road powers may agree in writing with the commission-
23 er to construct a specific project.

24 (b) A local government without road powers shall agree in writ-
25 ing with the commissioner to construct a specific project.

26 * Sec. 3. AS 19.30.211(b) is amended to read:

27 (b) The department shall continue maintenance on all projects
28 maintained by the department on January 1, 1980, unless requested not
29 to do so by the local government and the request is approved by the
