6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to medical and personal leave."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 39.20.256 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

9 (g) If an employee is terminated before he is eligible for a  
10 retirement benefit under AS 39.35 and the employee is reemployed within  
11 three years by the same employer, the banked medical leave accumulated  
12 by the employee at the time of his last termination shall be reinstated.

13 \* Sec. 2. AS 39.35 is amended by adding new sections to article 5 to  
14 read:

15 Sec. 39.35.365. MEDICAL LEAVE AS CREDITED SERVICE. (a) Upon  
16 retirement, an employee is entitled to credited service for accumulated  
17 medical leave. For purposes of determining credited service, the  
18 employee's accumulated medical leave shall be computed as credited  
19 service at the same rate of pay as his salary on retirement.

20 (b) A vested employee whose employment is terminated for any  
21 reason except retirement is entitled to credited service for his  
22 accumulated medical leave.

23 Sec. 39.35.367. PERSONAL LEAVE AS CREDITED SERVICE. Upon retire-  
24 ment, an employee may elect to receive credited service for accumulated  
25 personal leave. For purposes of determining credited service, the  
26 employee's accumulated personal leave shall be computed as credited  
27 service at the same rate of pay as his salary on retirement.
