5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making a driver improvement course mandatory
7 for young drivers who receive driving demerit points."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 28.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 28.15.225. DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE REQUIRED FOR YOUNG
11 DRIVERS RECEIVING POINTS. (a) In addition to the other consequences
12 of the assessment of points under AS 28.15.221 - 28.15.251, a driver
13 who is assessed points for an incident which occurs before the driver
14 reaches the age of 18 shall successfully complete a driver improvement
15 course approved by the department, during the 12-month period following
16 the assessment of points.

17 (b) If a driver who is required to successfully complete a driver
18 improvement course under this section fails to do so within the pre-
19 scribed 12-month period, the department shall suspend, revoke, or deny
20 that person's driver's license for a period of six months.

21 (c) A driver is not required to take more than one driver improve-
22 ment course under this section.
