5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing an advisory vote by the qualified
7 voters of the state on raising the age of majority to
8 21 for the purposes of regulation of alcoholic beverages,
9 and providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. The lieutenant governor shall place before the qualified
12 voters of the state at the next general election a question advisory to the
13 legislature of whether the legislature should enact laws which would raise
14 the age of majority from 19 to 21 years for the purpose of regulation of the
15 sale, consumption, service, furnishing, barter, purchase, gift, or delivery
16 of alcoholic beverages. The question shall appear on the ballot in the
17 following form:

19 Shall the Legislature of the State of Alaska enact laws raising
20 the age of majority from 19 to 21 years for the purpose of regu-
21 lation of the sale, consumption, service, furnishing, barter,
22 purchase, gift, or delivery of alcoholic beverages?
