6 For an Act entitled: "An Act limiting the effective period of administra-
7 tive regulations.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.62 is amended by adding a new section to article 4 to
10 read:

11 Sec. 44.62.295. LIMITATION ON EFFECTIVE PERIOD OF REGULATIONS.
12 No regulation adopted by an agency remains in effect beyond the 60th
13 day of the legislative session following adoption of the regulation
14 unless the regulation has been approved by law by that day. An expired
15 regulation is not effective for any purpose, but all rights, penalties,
16 forfeitures, or liability which accrued under the regulation before
17 that day continue and the regulation shall be treated as remaining in
18 force for the purpose of sustaining any proper action or prosecution
19 for the enforcement of a right, penalty, forfeiture, or liability which
20 accrued.
