6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to delayed registration of birth and
7 annulling regulations relating to delayed birth certi-
8 ficate; and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 18.50.180(d) is amended to read:

11 (d) When the birth occurred 12 years or more before the applica-
12 tion for registration, the certificate of birth shall be prepared on a
13 form entitled "delayed certificate of birth." The information provided
14 on this form shall be subscribed and sworn to by the person whose birth
15 is to be registered before an official authorized to administer oaths.
16 When a person is not competent to swear to this information it shall be
17 subscribed and sworn to by a parent, legal guardian, or his representa-
18 tive. The form shall provide for the name and sex of the person whose
19 birth is to be registered; the place and date of birth; and other
20 information required by the bureau. No other evidence of birth may be
21 required. [WHEN THE CERTIFICATE IS SUBMITTED, THE STATE REGISTRAR
22 SHALL ADD A DESCRIPTION AND AN ABSTRACT OF EACH DOCUMENT SUBMITTED IN
23 SUPPORT OF THE DELAYED REGISTRATION.] The original delayed certificate
24 of birth shall be filed with the bureau.

25 * Sec. 2. AS 18.50.180(e) and (f) are repealed.

26 * Sec. 3. 7 AAC 05.815, 7 AAC 05.820 and 7 AAC 05.825 are repealed.

27 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-
28 10.070(c).
