7 game tags, and fishing permits; and providing for an  
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 (6) Visitor's special sport fishing license -- valid for the  
12 period inscribed on the license

13 (A) For 14-day [10-DAY] license..... \$20 [\$15]

20 A nonresident may not take a big game animal without previously pur-  
21 chasing a numbered, nontransferable, appropriate tag, issued to him as  
22 provided in (16) of this subsection. The tag shall be affixed to the  
23 animal immediately upon capture and shall remain affixed until the  
24 animal is prepared for storage, consumed, or exported. A tag issued  
25 but not used for an animal may be used to satisfy the tagging require-  
26 ment for any other animal of the species named for which the tag fee is  
27 of equal or less value.

(d) Members of the military service on active duty who are permanently stationed in the state, and their dependents, who do not qualify as residents under AS 16.05.940(14), may obtain special non-resident military small game and sport fishing licenses at the rates for resident hunting and sport fishing licenses, but may not take a big game animal without previously purchasing a regular nonresident hunting license and a numbered, nontransferable appropriate tag, issued at one-half of the nonresident rate, under (a)(16) of this section.
