6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to provision for adequate housing for  
7 teachers in the public schools in rural areas."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.08.111 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (9) inform all employees of the housing circumstance  
11 generally and the specific problems in the specific assignment locations  
12 of the regional educational attendance area and assist employees to  
13 secure reasonable housing consistent with community norms as to sub-  
14 stance and quality at a reasonable cost (including energy and main-  
15 tenance costs).

16 \* Sec. 2. AS 14.14.090 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

17 (7) inform all employees of the housing circumstance  
18 generally and the specific problems in the specific assignment locations  
19 of the district and assist employees to secure reasonable housing  
20 consistent with community norms as to substance and quality at a  
21 reasonable cost (including energy and maintenance costs).

22 \* Sec. 3. AS 14.20.030 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

23 (b) A certificate may not be revoked or suspended under (a)(3) or  
24 (4) of this section for breach of contract if that breach by the  
25 certificate holder was based on the failure of the employing board to  
26 comply with the provisions of AS 14.08.111(9) or AS 14.14.090(7).
