6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the taking of game for the use
7 of incapacitated persons; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 16.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 16.05.407. TAKING GAME BY PROXY FOR THE INCAPACITATED. (a)
12 A resident, whether or not the holder of a valid hunting license, may
13 take game for the use of an incapacitated person under a hunting license
14 issued to the incapacitated person under (b) of this section if the
15 license of the incapacitated person is in the resident's actual possession.
16 A resident who hunts under a license issued to an incapacitated
17 person as well as a license issued to himself may exercise the sum of
18 the privileges which are granted under each of the licenses and which
19 by their nature are cumulative.

20 (b) A resident hunting license indicating that the holder is
21 incapacitated may be obtained from the Department of Revenue without
22 payment of the fee prescribed in AS 16.05.340 upon presentation of an
23 affidavit by the applicant or a physician stating that the applicant is
24 unable to hunt due to a defect, injury, disease, old age, or other
25 condition of body or mind. An incapacitated person must obtain a
26 license under this subsection regardless of whether the person is
27 exempt from the requirement of obtaining a license under AS 16.05.400.

28 * Sec. 2. A state department or agency may not adopt regulations implementing or interpreting sec. 1 of this Act.
