5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing that a person 17 years of age be
7 charged, prosecuted, and sentenced in the same manner
8 as an adult if accused of selling a drug on school
9 property."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 47.10.060 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

12 (f) If a minor who is at least 17 years of age is accused under
13 AS 17.10.010 or AS 17.12.010 of selling or attempting to sell a narco-
14 tic, depressant, hallucinogenic, or stimulant drug and the alleged sale
15 or attempted sale occurred on school property, the procedure prescribed
16 in AS 47.10.020 - 47.10.090 may not be followed, except that a parent,
17 guardian or legal custodian shall be present at all proceedings. A
18 minor who is at least 17 years of age who is accused under AS 17.10.010
19 or AS 17.12.010 of selling or attempting to sell a narcotic, depressant,
20 hallucinogenic, or stimulant drug and the alleged sale or attempted
21 sale occurred on school property shall be charged, prosecuted, and
22 sentenced in the same manner as an adult. As used in this subsection
23 "school property" means buildings used for publicly or privately oper-
24 ated elementary, junior high, or secondary schools which have been
25 accredited by the Department of Education, and includes land within 500
26 feet of the buildings and land used as part of an educational program
27 for parks, playgrounds, and athletic fields by the accredited schools.
