6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to nepotism in state employment; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.10.010 is repealed and reenacted to read:

10 Sec. 39.10.010. NEPOTISM PROHIBITED. (a) A person may not be
11 appointed to a position in a state department or agency, whether in the
12 legislative, judicial, or executive branch, if that person is the
13 spouse of or is related by blood or marriage within and including the
14 second degree of kindred to the commissioner or a deputy or assistant
15 commissioner of the principal department, or to the executive head of
16 the agency.

17 (b) A person may not be appointed to a position in a division of
18 a state department or agency, whether in the legislative, judicial, or
19 executive branch, if that person is the spouse of, or is related by
20 blood or marriage within and including the second degree of kindred to,
21 the executive head of the division.

22 (c) A person may not be appointed to a position in a state depart-
23 ment or agency in the executive branch, if that person is the spouse
24 of, or is related by blood or marriage within and including the second
25 degree of kindred to, an employee in the department or agency unless
26 the director of personnel and the person who makes the appointment
27 approve the appointment in writing. An appointment prohibited by (a)
28 or (b) of this section may not be approved under this subsection.

29 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
