6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to retirement benefits under the
7 teachers' retirement system; and providing for an
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 14.25 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 14.25.107. A member who joins the system on or after July 1,
12 1978, who has Alaska BIA service may claim all of that service. A
13 retirement benefit payable under this chapter for Alaska BIA service
14 shall be reduced by an amount equal to the retirement benefits paid to
15 the member by the United States government for the same service.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 14.25.060(c) is amended to read:

17 (c) The total military service claimed may not exceed five years.
18 The combined total of outside and military service may not exceed 10
19 years, except that, if entry into the armed forces is immediately
20 preceded by membership service and within one year after discharge is
21 continued by membership service, that service will not be counted for
22 purposes of determining the applicability of the 10-year limitation on
23 the combined total of outside and military service. [THE COMBINED
24 TOTAL OF OUTSIDE, MILITARY, AND ALASKA BIA SERVICE MAY NOT EXCEED 15
25 YEARS.]

26 * Sec. 3. AS 14.25.220(10) is amended to read:

27 (10) "credited service" means all membership service as
28 provided in (20) of this section, [PLUS OUTSIDE, MILITARY, AND BIA
29 SERVICE NOT EXCEEDING 15 YEARS,] with outside and military service

1 limited to 10 years except under the conditions set out in AS 14.25.-
2 100;

3 * Sec. 4. AS 14.25.060(b)(3) is repealed.

4 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
5 070(c).
