For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska Railroad Transfer
7 Advisory Commission; and providing for an effective
8 date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10

* Section 1. ALASKA RAILROAD TRANSFER ADVISORY COMMISSION. (a) There is
11 established in the Office of the Governor the Alaska Railroad Transfer
12 Advisory Commission.

(b) The Alaska Railroad Transfer Advisory Commission consists of the
14 commissioner of transportation and public facilities or his designee, a
15 member of the house appointed by the speaker of the house, a member of the
16 senate appointed by the president of the senate, and four public members
17 appointed by the governor. The public members must have experience in a
18 field related to the management and operation of a railroad, including but
19 not limited to transportation, business, and finance. The public members
20 shall be residents and qualified voters of the state. Public members of the
21 commission serve without compensation but are entitled to travel and per diem
22 as authorized by law for members of boards and commissions.

23

(c) The Alaska Railroad Transfer Advisory Commission shall advise the
24 legislature and the governor with respect to all issues concerning the trans-
25 fer of the Alaska Railroad to non-federal ownership.

26

(d) The Alaska Railroad Transfer Advisory Commission shall review
27 alternative structures for the long-term management and operation of the
28 Alaska Railroad by public or private entities following the transition from
29 federal to state ownership and may make recommendatons to the legislature and

1 the governor.

2 * Sec. 2. The existence of the Alaska Railroad Transfer Advisory Commis-
3 sion is terminated upon ratification by the legislature of the closing report
4 or a substantive equivalent prepared and submitted under the federal transfer
5 legislation, upon other disposition of the Alaska Railroad by the federal
6 government, or on January 1, 1985, whichever is earlier.

7 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
8 070(c).
