6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to waste heat produced by certain
7 pipeline facilities; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 38.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 38.35.226. CONSTRUCTION OF PUMP AND COMPRESSOR STATIONS.

12 (a) The commissioner may require a stipulation in a lease that a pump
13 or compressor station designed or constructed after July 1, 1982, for
14 an oil, natural gas, or natural gas liquids pipeline on state land
15 leased under this chapter shall be designed and constructed so that
16 waste heat produced by the pump or compressor station may be used in
17 the state.

18 (b) A waste heat facility may not be required under a stipulation
19 in a lease unless

20 (1) the waste heat facility is technologically possible and
21 economically feasible; and

22 (2) the waste heat facility is compatible with the pipeline
23 facility and does not interfere with the operation of the pipeline or
24 create safety or environmental hazards.

25 (c) The owner of the pipeline or the lessee may charge to the
26 purchaser of the waste heat the additional cost of constructing a pump
27 or compressor station for use of waste heat as required by (b) of this
28 section. The amount of money to be paid for the waste heat generated
29 by a pump or compressor station shall be determined under terms of a

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contract negotiated between the owner and the purchaser of the waste heat.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 1982.
