A BILL

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For an Act entitled: "An Act confirming that Alaska Pioneers' Homes are not
7 subject to the requirements of AS 18.07 and are not
8 required to obtain a certificate of need under that
9 chapter; and providing for an effective date."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

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* Section 1. The purpose of this Act is solely to clarify and confirm
12 that Alaska Pioneers' Homes are not, and never have been, subject to the
13 provisions of AS 18.07.

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* Sec. 2. AS 18.07.111(7) is amended to read:

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(7) "health care facility" means a private, municipal, state

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or federal hospital, psychiatric hospital, tuberculosis hospital,

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skilled nursing facility, kidney disease treatment center (including

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freestanding hemodialysis units), intermediate care facility, and

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ambulatory surgical facility; the term excludes

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(A) an Alaska Pioneers' Home administered by the

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Department of Administration under AS 44.21.020 and AS 47.25.010 -

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47.25.100; and

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(B) the offices of private physicians or dentists

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whether in individual or group practice;

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* Sec. 3. This Act is retroactive to June 29, 1976.

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* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-

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070(c).

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
