6 For an Act entitled: "An Act repealing the requirement that the person
7 managing or administering an Alaska Pioneers' Home be
8 a licensed nursing home administrator; and providing
9 for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 08.70.080 is amended to read:

12 Sec. 08.70.080. LICENSE REQUIRED. Only a licensed nursing home
13 administrator may manage, supervise, or be generally in charge of a
14 nursing home. The care provided by a nursing home or a licensed hos-
15 pital providing nursing home care through the use of skilled nursing
16 beds or intermediate care beds shall be supervised by a licensed nursing
17 home administrator or by a person exempted from licensure requirements
18 under this section. This section does not apply to persons engaged on
19 July 1, 1980, in managing or administering [AN ALASKA PIONEERS' HOME OR]
20 a hospital with skilled nursing beds or intermediate care beds. This
21 section does not apply to persons engaged in managing, supervising, or
22 administering an Alaska Pioneers' Home under AS 47.25.

23 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
24 070(c).
