6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the amount which may be retained
7 by persons collecting hunting and fishing license and
8 tag fees."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 16.05.390 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 16.05.390. FEE FOR ISSUANCE OF LICENSES AND TAGS. A person
12 appointed and authorized by the commissioner of revenue to sell licenses
13 and tags, except a salaried employee of the state, is entitled to keep
14 25 [FIVE] percent of the fee for the issuance of each license or tag [,
15 OR A FEE OF 25 CENTS, WHICHEVER IS GREATER]. Each person selling
16 licenses or tags shall, as soon as practicable after the last day of
17 each calendar month, transmit the proceeds from the sales, except the
18 amount authorized to be retained, together with a report of the sales
19 to the commissioner for deposit in the fish and game fund or the
20 general fund. Fees imposed under AS 16.05.340(e) shall be collected
21 and transmitted in the same manner and to the same source as license
22 and tag fees provided for under this chapter.
