6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the compensation of persons col-
7 lecting hunting and fishing license and tag fees."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05.390 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 16.05.390. FEE FOR ISSUANCE OF LICENSES AND TAGS. A person
11 appointed and authorized by the commissioner of revenue to sell licenses
12 and tags, except a salaried employee of the state, is entitled to
13 be compensated at a rate of \$50 per year or \$1 per license or tag sold
14 during the year [KEEP FIVE PERCENT OF THE FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF EACH
15 LICENSE OR TAG, OR A FEE OF 25 CENTS], whichever is greater. Each
16 person selling licenses or tags shall, as soon as practicable after the
17 last day of each calendar month, transmit the proceeds from the sales
18 [, EXCEPT THE AMOUNT AUTHORIZED TO BE RETAINED,] together with a report
19 of the sales to the commissioner for deposit in the fish and game fund
20 or the general fund. Fees imposed under AS 16.05.340(e) shall be
21 collected and transmitted in the same manner and to the same source as
22 license and tag fees provided for under this chapter.
