6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the compensation of persons col-
7 lecting hunting and fishing license and tag fees."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05.390 is repealed and reenacted to read:

10 Sec. 16.05.390. FEES AND COMPENSATION FOR ISSUANCE OF LICENSES
11 AND TAGS. (a) A person appointed and authorized by the commissioner
12 of revenue, except a salaried employee of the state, is entitled to:

13 (1) retain five percent of the fee for the issuance of a
14 license or tag or 25 cents for each license or tag sold, whichever is
15 greater; and

16 (2) compensation of \$50 per year or \$1 for each license or
17 tag sold during the year, whichever is greater.

18 (b) Each person authorized to sell licenses or tags under this
19 section shall, as soon as practicable after the last day of each
20 calendar month, transmit the proceeds from the sales of licenses and
21 tags, except the amount authorized to be retained, together with a
22 report of the sales to the commissioner for deposit in the fish and
23 game fund or the general fund. Fees imposed under AS 16.05.340(e)
24 shall be collected and transmitted in the same manner and to the same
25 source as license and tag fees provided for under this chapter.
