5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the establishment of a Joint
7 Legislative Committee on the Alaska Veterans and
8 Pioneers Memorial Museum; and providing for an effective
9 date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF COMMITTEE. The Joint Legislative Com-
12 mittee on the Alaska Veterans and Pioneers Memorial Museum is established.

13 * Sec. 2. COMPOSITION. The committee consists of the following persons:

14 (1) three members of the senate appointed by the president of the
15 senate;

16 (2) three members of the house of representatives appointed by
17 the speaker of the house of representatives.

18 * Sec. 3. COMPENSATION. A member of the committee serves without
19 compensation, but is entitled to per diem and travel expenses authorized by
20 law for boards and commissions under AS 39.20.180.

21 * Sec. 4. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE COMMITTEE. (a) The committee shall

22 (1) plan for the establishment of the Alaska Veterans and Pioneers
23 Memorial Museum;

24 (2) make recommendations to the legislature concerning

25 (A) the construction of a museum facility;

26 (B) the administration and operation of the museum.

27 (b) The committee may hire an executive director and additional
28 professional and administrative staff as may be necessary to the function of
29 the committee.

1 * Sec. 5. REPORT. The committee shall file a report stating its
2 recommendations with the governor and the legislature by February 15, 1982.

3 * Sec. 6. DEFINITION. In this Act "committee" means the Joint Legis-
4 lative Committee on the Alaska Veterans and Pioneers Memorial Museum.

5 * Sec. 7. TERMINATION. This Act is repealed and the existence of the
6 committee terminated one year from the effective date of this Act.

7 * Sec. 8. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
8 070(c).
