4 TWELFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to military and pioneer history and
7 establishing a Committee on the Alaska Military and
8 Pioneers Memorial Museum; and providing for an effec-
9 tive date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF COMMITTEE. The Committee on the Alaska
12 Military and Pioneers Memorial Museum is established.

13 * Sec. 2. COMPOSITION. The committee consists of the following persons:

14 (1) two members of the senate appointed by the president of the
15 senate;

16 (2) two members of the house of representatives appointed by the
17 speaker of the house of representatives;

18 (3) three members appointed by the governor.

19 * Sec. 3. COMPENSATION. A member of the committee serves without compen-
20 sation, but is entitled to per diem and travel expenses authorized by law
21 for boards and commissions under AS 39.20.180.

22 * Sec. 4. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE COMMITTEE. (a) The committee shall

23 (1) plan for the establishment of the Alaska Military and Pioneers
24 Memorial Museum;

25 (2) make recommendations to the legislature concerning

26 (A) the construction of a museum facility;

27 (B) the administration and operation of the museum;

28 (3) cooperate with the state museum to determine appropriate
29 means of presenting the military history of the Aleutian Island Chain,

1 including the displacement of the Aleut people, and Alaska pioneer history;

2 (4) cooperate with the state museum in the development of plans
3 to survey, inventory, and preserve historically significant material from
4 the Aleutian Island Chain;

5 (5) assist the state museum in developing long-range plans for
6 statewide programs in cultural and historic preservation and interpretation
7 that are either not included in existing museum services or are inadequate
8 in scope, including programs related to military and pioneer history.

9 (b) The committee may hire an executive director and additional pro-
10 fessional and administrative staff as may be necessary to the function of
11 the committee.

12 * Sec. 5. REPORT. The committee shall file a report stating its recom-
13 mendations with the governor and the legislature by February 15, 1982.

14 * Sec. 6. DEFINITION. In this Act "committee" means the Committee on
15 the Alaska Military and Pioneers Memorial Museum.

16 * Sec. 7. TERMINATION. This Act is repealed and the existence of the
17 committee terminated one year from the effective date of this Act.

18 * Sec. 8. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
19 070(c).

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
