6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making special appropriations for an asbestos
7 health hazard program; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. The sum of \$60,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
11 the Department of Environmental Conservation for programs to train personnel
12 of schools, public facilities, local governments, and other institutions in
13 inspection and sampling methods to assess asbestos health hazards.

14 * Sec. 2. The sum of \$3,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
15 the Department of Community and Regional Affairs for distribution to school
16 officials in the state to renovate school buildings to eliminate asbestos
17 health hazards.

18 * Sec. 3. The sum of \$1,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
19 the Department of Community and Regional Affairs for renovations to public
20 facilities to eliminate asbestos health hazards.

21 * Sec. 4. The unexpended and unobligated portions of the appropriations
22 made by this Act lapse into the general fund June 30, 1982.

23 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect on the effective date of an Act estab-
24 lishing an asbestos health hazard program.
