For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the issuance of general obligation bonds in the amount of \$53,784,000 for the purpose of paying the cost of capital improvements for elementary and secondary schools and vocational-technical education facilities; and providing for an effective date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. For the purpose of paying the cost of capital improvements for elementary and secondary schools and vocational-technical education facilities, general obligation bonds of the state in the principal amount of not more than \$53,784,000 shall be issued and sold. None of these bonds may be issued or sold until February 15, 1983. The full faith, credit, and resources of the state are pledged to the payment of the principal of and interest and redemption premium, if any, on these bonds. These bonds shall be issued under the provisions of AS 37.15 as those provisions read at the time of issuance.

* Sec. 2. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the qualified voters of the state, a special fund of the state to be known as the "1982 Elementary and Secondary Schools and Vocational-Technical Education Facilities Construction Fund" shall be established, to which shall be credited the proceeds of the sale of the bonds described in sec. 1 of this Act except for the accrued interest and premiums.

9 * Sec. 20. The amount of \$200,000 is appropriated from the "1982 Elemen-
10 tary and Secondary Schools and Vocational-Technical Education Facilities
11 Construction Fund" to the Department of Education for Saint Mary's school
12 upgrade.

13 * Sec. 21. The amount of \$500,000 is appropriated from the "1982 Elemen-
14 tary and Secondary Schools and Vocational-Technical Education Facilities
15 Construction Fund" to the Department of Education for Yukon/Koyukuk district
16 health and life safety code upgrade.

17 * Sec. 22. The amount of \$4,100,000 is appropriated from the "1982 Elemen-
18 tary and Secondary Schools and Vocational-Technical Education Facilities
19 Construction Fund" to the Department of Education for Skagway school, phase
20 II.

21 * Sec. 23. The amount of \$4,900,000 is appropriated from the "1982 Elemen-
22 tary and Secondary Schools and Vocational-Technical Education Facilities
23 Construction Fund" to the Department of Education for the Alaska vocational
24 technical center student services center.

25 * Sec. 24. (a) The amounts appropriated for projects in secs. 3 to 22 of
26 this Act may be reappropriated among the projects by law.

27 (b) Excess money not needed for a project listed in this Act may be
28 reallocated by the Department of Education to another project listed in this
29 Act. The authority granted by this subsection may not be used to eliminate a

1 project listed in this Act.

2 * Sec. 25. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the qualified
3 voters of the state, the amount of \$188,300 or as much of that amount as is
4 found necessary is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the
5 state bond committee to carry out the provisions of this Act and to pay
6 expenses incident to the sale and issuance of the bonds authorized in this
7 Act. The amounts expended from the appropriation authorized by this section
8 shall be reimbursed to the general fund from the proceeds of the sale of the
9 bonds authorized by this Act.

10 * Sec. 26. The amount withdrawn from the public facility planning fund
11 for the purpose of advance planning for the improvements financed under this
12 Act shall be reimbursed to the fund from the proceeds of the sale of bonds
13 authorized by this Act.

14 * Sec. 27. The question whether the bonds authorized in this Act are to
15 be issued shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the state at the next
16 general election and shall read substantially as follows:
