6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing commissioned officers and com-
7 manders of units of the armed forces of the United
8 States to perform the functions of a notary public in
9 the state; and providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 44.50 is amended by adding a new section to read:

12 Sec. 44.50.185. COMMISSIONED OFFICERS AND COMMANDERS OF UNITS OF
13 THE ARMED FORCES AS NOTARIES. (a) A commissioned officer or a comman-
14 der of a unit in the armed forces of the United States may perform the
15 functions of a notary public in the state.

16 (b) An official act of a commissioned officer or commander per-
17 forming the function of a notary public shall be signed by the officer
18 or commander and shall set out his official rank and title. An offi-
19 cial seal is not required to authenticate an official act performed
20 under this section.

21 (c) A commissioned officer or commander who performs the func-
22 tions of a notary public is not required to post a bond or to obtain a
23 commission as a notary public in the state.

24 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
25 070(c).
