6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to agricultural development projects;
7 making clarifying amendments and ratifying certain
8 actions; and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. FINDINGS AND RATIFICATION. The legislature finds that it
11 is in the public interest for prequalification requirements for agricultural
12 development projects to include, at the discretion of the project administra-
13 tor, the submission of conservation plans, development plans, or other
14 plans, schedules, or programs from persons who apply to participate in the
15 projects. The legislature further finds it is in the public interest that
16 the administrators have authority to classify tracts in agricultural develop-
17 ment projects for each type of agricultural use. The legislature further
18 finds that existing law authorizes these actions but that clarifying amend-
19 ments will aid in interpreting the law. The legislature accordingly ratifies
20 the actions taken by the administrators of the agricultural action projects
21 with respect to prequalification requirements and classification of tracts.

* Sec. 4. AS 44.33.470(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(3) classify tracts for different agricultural uses and require prequalification, including the submission of conservation plans, development plans, or other plans, schedules, or programs, of persons who apply to participate in an agricultural development project.

* Sec. 5. Sections 2 - 4 of this Act are retroactive to January 1, 1980.

* Sec. 6. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-070(c).
