6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making a special appropriation to the Depart-
 7 ment of Transportation and Public Facilities to correct
 8 fire and life safety deficiencies in regional educa-
 9 tional attendance area schools; and providing for an
 10 effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. The sum of \$17,198,300 is appropriated from the general
 13 fund to the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to correct
 14 fire and life safety deficiencies in regional educational attendance area
 15 schools to be allocated as follows:
