8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 12.30.040(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of (a) of this section, if the  
11 offense a person has been convicted of is murder [IN THE FIRST DEGREE,  
12 ROBBERY IN THE FIRST DEGREE], kidnapping, a class A felony, or a class  
13 B felony [SEXUAL ASSAULT IN THE FIRST DEGREE UNDER AS 11.41.410(a)(1)],  
14 he may not be released on bail either before sentencing or pending  
15 appeal.
