5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making special appropriations for the costs  
7 of relocating the native village of Mary's Igloo; and  
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. The sum of \$1,550,000 is appropriated from the general  
11 fund to the Department of Community and Regional Affairs for payment as a  
12 grant to the native village of Mary's Igloo for the costs of its relocation  
13 to the traditional Kawerak site as follows:

14	planning	\$ 50,000
15	housing units	1,500,000

16 \* Sec. 2. The sum of \$4,500,000 is appropriated from the general fund  
17 to the Department of Transportation for costs associated with the relocation  
18 of the native village of Mary's Igloo to be appropriated as follows:

19	Mary's Igloo airport	\$1,500,000
20	Bering Straits REAA - Mary's Igloo School	3,000,000

21 \* Sec. 3. The sum of \$3,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund  
22 to the Department of Fish and Game for a fish hatchery at Pilgrim Hot Springs.

23 \* Sec. 4. The sum of \$300,000 is appropriated from the general fund to  
24 the Department of Natural Resources to be paid as a grant to the Nome Reindeer  
25 Herders Association for a reindeer processing plant in Pilgrim Hot Springs.

26 \* Sec. 5. The appropriations made in secs. 1 and 4 of this Act shall be  
27 disbursed in accordance with AS 37.05.315.

28 \* Sec. 6. The appropriations made in secs. 3 and 4 of this Act are for  
29 capital projects and are subject to AS 37.25.020.
