6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to driver education in the public
7 schools in the state."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 28 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 18. DRIVER EDUCATION SUPPORT PROGRAM.

11 Sec. 28.18.010. PROGRAM ESTABLISHED. A support program for
12 driver education in the public schools of the state is established.
13 The support program shall be administered by the Department of Education
14 for the purpose of providing money to local schools for approved public
15 school driver education courses.

16 Sec. 28.18.020. ELIGIBILITY FOR SUPPORT. A city or borough
17 school district or a regional educational attendance area may apply for
18 money under this chapter to operate driver education courses by submit-
19 ting a driver education course plan to the Department of Education
20 containing

- 21 (1) provisions for classroom courses;
22 (2) provisions for driving experience; and
23 (3) other course plan provisions required by the Department
24 of Education.

25 Sec. 28.18.030. DUTIES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION. To carry
26 out the provisions of this chapter the Department of Education shall

- 27 (1) establish, by regulation, criteria for its approval of
28 public school driver education courses;
29 (2) approve or disapprove each application for support money

1 for driver education courses under this chapter, in accordance with the
2 criteria established under (1) of this section;

3 (3) administer and distribute money appropriated by the
4 legislature to the Department of Education for public school driver
5 education courses to applicants whose course plans have been approved
6 under this chapter.
