8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 44.12.045. MARTIN LUTHER KING DAY. January 15 is designated  
11 Martin Luther King Day to honor Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., for his  
12 tireless efforts and devotion in the advancement of justice, equality  
13 and human dignity of all people. Martin Luther King Day may be observed  
14 by suitable observances and exercises by civic groups and the public.
