6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the planning of a Medical and
7 Health Services School in the University of Alaska at
8 Anchorage."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. The University of Alaska shall publish a plan for a Medical
11 and Health Services School in Anchorage with undergraduate, graduate, and
12 postgraduate programs to be accredited by 1990. The plan shall provide for

13 (1) the training of students to meet the unique medical needs of
14 rural Alaskans, including the preparatory training of students in elementary,
15 secondary, and postsecondary institutions;

16 (2) agreements for affiliation and collaboration with accredited
17 medical and health schools;

18 (3) the use of in-state hospitals and health facilities for train-
19 ing purposes;

20 (4) the establishment in the state of a family practice residency
21 program; and

22 (5) the establishment of continuing education programs for Alaska
23 doctors.

24 * Sec. 2. The plan developed under this Act shall be submitted to the
25 legislature not later than December 31, 1983.
