5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing state-paid per diem to members of the  
7 Alaska National Guard and Naval Militia while on active-  
8 duty training required for advancement in or retention  
9 of rank."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. AS 26.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

12 Sec. 26.05.262. STATE-PAID PER DIEM. Each member of the Alaska  
13 National Guard or Naval Militia who is required to attend active-duty  
14 training for more than 16 days at a training site away from his place of  
15 residence in order to retain his rank or be advanced in rank is entitled  
16 to receive per diem for each day of the training. Per diem under this  
17 section is in addition to pay and allowances received under AS 26.05.260.  
18 Per diem under this section should be paid at the same rate allowed for  
19 a state employee under AS 39.20.110 and 39.20.160, including regional  
20 variations in the rate where applicable. Short-term or long-term per  
21 diem shall be paid in accordance with regulations adopted by the commis-  
22 sioner of administration under AS 39.20.160. Per diem under this section  
23 shall be paid from appropriations from the state general fund.
