6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to games of chance and contests of
7 skill; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 05.15.040 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 05.15.040. ISSUANCE AND EFFECT AND TERM OF PERMIT. After the
11 fee is paid, a permit issued, and during the effective period of the
12 permit, the municipality or qualified organization may conduct the
13 activity specified in the permit. If a permit is revoked, the permittee
14 is not eligible for another permit until the expiration of one year from
15 the date of revocation. A permit expires at the end of the period for
16 which it is issued. A permit is not transferable.

17 * Sec. 2. AS 05.15.100 is amended to read:

18 Sec. 05.15.100. COMMISSIONER OF REVENUE MAY ISSUE PERMITS. The
19 commissioner of revenue may issue a permit to a municipality or qualified
20 organization. The permit gives the municipality or organization the
21 privilege of conducting games of chance and contests of skill including
22 bingo, raffles and lotteries, ice classics, rain classics, dog mushers'
23 contests, and fish derbies [AND CONTESTS OF SKILL].

24 * Sec. 3. AS 05.15.120 is amended to read:

25 Sec. 05.15.120. ELIGIBILITY FOR PERMIT. An applicant shall be a
26 municipality or qualified organization to be eligible for a permit.

27 * Sec. 4. AS 05.15.140 is amended to read:

28 Sec. 05.15.140. PROOF NECESSARY TO QUALIFY FOR PERMIT. The com-
29 missioner of revenue may not issue or renew a permit except upon satis-

(22) "business league" means an association of persons formed to promote a common business interest and that does not itself engage in business for profit;

(23) "game of chance" means a game (including pull-tabs and punchboards) in which the price of each chance is \$1 or less and in which the skill and experience of the player is secondary to purely fortuitous or accidental circumstances incidental to the game;

(24) "municipality" means a political subdivision of the state that is a home rule or general law city or borough or a unified municipality;

(25) "political action organization" means an organization that seeks to influence the outcome of a state or municipal election or to influence an elected or appointed public officer in the performance of duty.
