6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing a drug abuse grant program."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 47.37.040 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

9 (20) administer the drug abuse grant program established under
10 AS 47.37.265.

11 * Sec. 2. AS 47.37 is amended by adding a new section to read:

12 ARTICLE 2. DRUG ABUSE GRANTS.

13 Sec. 47.37.265. DRUG ABUSE GRANT PROGRAM. (a) A drug abuse grant
14 program is established in the office to provide money to municipalities
15 and unincorporated communities to enable them to enforce drug laws, to
16 provide treatment for drug abusers, and to provide educational programs
17 on drug abuse.

18 (b) Factors to be considered by the office in considering drug
19 abuse project applications include, but are not limited to, the need of
20 the applicant for the project and the resources of the applicant that
21 will be available to implement the project.

22 (c) The office shall establish an application procedure for grants
23 for specific drug abuse projects under this section.

24 * Sec. 3. AS 47.37.270 is amended by adding new paragraphs to read:

25 (14) "municipality" means a city, borough, or unified municipi-
26 pality incorporated under state law, including home rule and general law
27 municipalities;

28 (15) "unincorporated community" means a place in the unorgan-
29 ized borough not incorporated as a municipality, in which 25 or more

persons reside as a social unit.
