6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to expiration of regulations; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.62 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 44.62.025. EXPIRATION OF REGULATIONS. (a) Except as provided
11 in (b) of this section, a regulation adopted by a state agency expires
12 at the end of a period of five years from its effective date unless the
13 regulation specifies an earlier expiration date. An expired regulation
14 is not effective for any purpose, but all rights, penalties, forfeitures,
15 or liability which had accrued under the regulation before the expiration
16 date continue and the regulation shall be treated as remaining in force
17 for the purpose of sustaining any proper action or prosecution for the
18 enforcement of a right, penalty, forfeiture, or liability that had
19 accrued. A new regulation adopted under this chapter may contain all or
20 part of the provisions of an expired regulation. If a new regulation
21 containing provisions identical to an expired regulation is adopted
22 before the expiration date, the provisions are considered to have con-
23 tinuous effect.

24 (b) Each regulation adopted by a state agency before the effective
25 date of this Act expires at a time specified in the resolution or in the
26 month and year set out after each, whichever is earlier:

27 (1) regulations contained in Titles 4, 12, 16, and 17 of the
28 Alaska Administrative Code -- January 1983;

29 (2) regulations contained in Titles 1, 2, 3, 5, and 6 of the

1 Alaska Administrative Code and all uncodified regulations -- January
2 1984;

3 (3) regulations contained in Titles 7, 8, 10, 20, and 21 of
4 the Alaska Administrative Code -- January 1985;

5 (4) regulations contained in Titles 9, 11, 13, and 14 of the
6 Alaska Administrative Code -- January 1986;

7 (5) regulations contained in Titles 15, 18, and 19 of the
8 Alaska Administrative Code -- January 1987.

9 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
10 070(c).
