6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to sentencing of persons convicted of
7 driving while intoxicated."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 28.35.030(c) is amended to read:

10 (c) Upon conviction under this section the court shall impose a
11 minimum sentence of imprisonment of not less than 72 [THREE] consecutive
12 hours [DAYS]. Upon a subsequent conviction within five years after a
13 conviction under this section, the court shall impose a minimum sentence
14 of imprisonment of not less than 240 [10] consecutive hours [DAYS]. The
15 execution of sentence may not be suspended nor may probation be granted
16 until the minimum imprisonment provided in this section has been served.
17 Imposition of sentence may not be suspended, except upon the condition
18 that the defendant be imprisoned for no less than the minimum period
19 provided in this section. In addition, his operator's license shall be
20 revoked in accordance with AS 28.15.181. In addition, a person convicted
21 under this statute shall undertake, for a term specified by the court,
22 that program of alcohol education or rehabilitation which the court,
23 after consideration of any information compiled under (d) of this sec-
24 tion, finds appropriate.
