6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state grants to named recipients;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 37.05.316 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 37.05.316. GRANTS TO NAMED RECIPIENTS. (a) When an amount
11 is appropriated or allocated to a department as a grant for a named
12 recipient that is not a municipality, the department to which the
13 appropriation or allocation is made shall promptly notify the named
14 recipient of the availability of the grant and request the named
15 recipient to submit a proposal to provide the goods or services speci-
16 fied in the appropriation act, or both, for which the appropriation or
17 allocation is made. At the same time, the department may issue a
18 request for proposals from other qualified persons to provide the same
19 goods or services, or both, in the same area. The department shall
20 contract with the named recipient unless the Office of the Governor,
21 with due regard for any local expertise or experience among those making
22 proposals, determines that an award of the contract to a different party
23 would better serve the public interest. If the contract is awarded to
24 another party than that named by the legislature, the basis of that
25 action shall be stated in writing at the time the grant is issued and a
26 copy of the written statement shall be sent to the Legislative Budget
27 and Audit Committee. [A CONTRACT SHALL BE EXECUTED WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER
28 THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE APPROPRIATION OR ALLOCATION.] The purchase of
29 the goods or services, or both, shall be in accordance with AS 37.05.-

2 * Sec. 2. AS 37.05.316 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

3 (b) When the Department of Administration receives an agreement
4 executed by the party to whom the contract was awarded which provides
5 that the party (1) will spend the grant for the purposes specified in
6 the appropriation or allocation; (2) will allow, on request, an audit by
7 the state of the uses made of the grant; and (3) assures that, to the
8 extent consistent with the purpose of the appropriation or allocation,
9 the facilities and services provided with the grant will be available
10 for the use of the general public, the Department of Administration
11 shall pay the grant directly to the party. The executed agreement shall
12 be on a form furnished by the Department of Administration and shall be
13 executed within 60 days after the effective date of the appropriation or
14 allocation.

15 (c) Not less than 20 percent of a grant shall be paid to a party
16 within 10 days of the effective date of the agreement under (b) of this
17 section. The remainder of the grant shall be paid either in monthly
18 installments equal to the amount of grant money the party expended in
19 the previous month or in a lump sum as determined by the Department of
20 Administration.
