6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to sexual assault."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 11.41.420 is repealed and reenacted to read:

9 Sec. AS 11.41.420. SEXUAL ASSAULT IN THE SECOND DEGREE (a) A
10 person commits the crime of sexual assault in the second degree if he
11 engages in

12 (1) sexual contact with another person without consent of
13 that person; or

14 (2) sexual penetration with a person who he knows

15 (A) is suffering from a mental disorder or defect which
16 renders him incapable of appraising the nature of the conduct under
17 circumstances in which a person who is capable of appraising the
18 nature of the conduct would not engage in sexual penetration; or

19 (B) is incapacitated.

20 (b) Sexual assault in the second degree is a class B felony.
