6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the size of trapping cabins."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 38.95.080(c) is amended to read:

9 (c) The director shall establish, by regulation, conditions attach-
10 ing to the permit issued under (a) and (b) of this section. These
11 conditions shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

12 (1) permits shall be issued for a period of not more than 10
13 years, with succeeding 10-year renewal options, if periodic [CONTINUED]
14 use and occupancy is established, and the qualifications of (a) of this
15 section continue to be met;

16 (2) a cabin shall be constructed and maintained according to
17 reasonable specifications established by the director; one cabin con-
18 structed under a permit may contain not more than 400 square feet; how-
19 ever, in no case may another [A LINE] cabin constructed under the same
20 permit exceed 192 square feet;

21 (3) a permit shall specify the number of cabins allowed to be
22 constructed and indicate their specific geographical location; the
23 director may establish a maximum number of cabins per person or otherwise
24 limit their number because of the probability of adverse consequences;

25 (4) adequate provision must be made at each cabin for waste
26 and garbage disposal, as determined by the director;

27 (5) the payment of a trapping cabin permit fee of \$10.
